This certificate program requires concurrent enrollment in the Master of Education major in Special Education (Behavioral Disorders/Positive Behavior Supports Concentration) (<http://mycatalog.txstate.edu/graduate/education/curriculum-instruction/special-education-behavioral-med/>) at Texas State University.

The post-baccalaureate certificate in Behavioral Disorders/Positive Behavioral Supports requires 21 semester credit hours.
