General Requirements

- A Texas State Accounting major may apply for admittance to the M.Acy. program once the student has completed the following:
 - at least 90 credit hours,
 - at least 12 upper-level Accounting courses, and
 - ACC 3313 and ACC 3314 with a grade of "B" or better.
- All applicants to the M.Acy. program will provide the following:
 - a completed online ApplyTexas application
 - a \$40 nonrefundable application fee
 - at least two completed reference forms,
 - a resume/CV
 - GMAT or GRE score, and
 - an essay on the topic indicated in the application materials.

However, submission of the GMAT or GRE score and essay will be optional for a Texas State Accounting major who:

- has earned a 3.2 GPA or higher in the last 60 of coursework,
- has earned a 3.4 GPA or higher in upper-level Accounting courses, and
- provides at least two satisfactory reference forms from Texas State faculty.
